Gabriel Plassat is an engineer specializing in mobility solutions for people and goods, engines and fuels as well as the use of digital innovation for transportation. After having worked at PSA as an Engine Architecture Engineer, he joined the ADEME (French Environment and Energy Management Agency) as a specialist in thermal engines and fuels. In 2018, he co-founded the Fabrique des Mobilités, a French NGO that brings together mobility stakeholders (local communities, companies, and private citizens) to provide them with information and solutions.

In parallel, he advises the European Commission on clean vehicle technologies and innovative urban transport systems. He is also an expert for the European Executive Agency Trans-European Transport Network (TEN-T) for the deployment of innovative pilot infrastructures.

He also teaches courses on mobility and innovation at several engineering and business schools, such as ESTACA (Ecole Supérieure des Techniques Aéronautiques et de Construction Automobile), ENPC (Ecole Nationale des Ponts et Chaussées), SKEMA Business school and ENSPM IFP School (Ecole Nationale Supérieure du Pétrole et des Moteurs).

He is the author of *"Mobilités et Transports du Futur - Quelles rencontres pour le 21ème siècle"*, a book which explores innovative transportation means for the future of mobility, and a blog that serves as a connector in the mobility ecosystem (mystrikingly.com).
